

Night Works: Mortdale Town Centre Upgrade

Project Description: Streetscape improvement works to increase pedestrian safety and amenity along Morts Road between Mortdale Train Station and Martin Place. This work includes removing all overhead electricity infrastructure, repaving footpaths, installing new street furniture, landscaping and upgrading traffic calming devices.





Due to the large volume of traffic and pedestrian activity in the Mortdale shopping precinct during normal working hours, night construction works are required to undertake the majority of the town centre upgrade project.

Night Work Hours: Works will be undertaken intermittently throughout May, subject to weather, site conditions and execution of work by NBN. Any changes to this timing will be communicated on the website as provided by the contractor.

Hours of operation are from **9:00 pm to 5:00 am**, Monday to Friday.

Night Work Will Include: The removal of existing electrical infrastructure, minor excavation works, kerb realignments, drainage improvements, paving finalisation, installation of street furniture and landscaping.

Where possible the contractor will aim to complete the noisiest works by midnight to minimise impact to residents.

For safety, vehicles may make an audible warning alert when moving.</p>	<p>Access </p> <p>Sections of Morts Road and surrounding streets may be closed while works are being complete. Resident accessibility will remain in place.</p>	<p>Traffic </p> <p>Machinery & trucks may take space up on the street. Traffic controllers will ensure traffic flow and community safety.</p>	<p>Parking </p> <p>During work, on street parking around work zones may be limited to enable works to occur and park equipment nearby.</p>
