## Acknowledgement of country

Georges River Council acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation, who are the Traditional Custodians of all lands, waters and sky in the Georges River area. Council recognises Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as an integral part of the Georges River community and values their social and cultural contributions. We pay our respect to their Elders past and present and extend that respect to all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples who live work and meet on these lands.

## Introduction

Council has developed a Street Tree Master Plan to ensure appropriate tree species are selected, planted and maintained. Making the right decisions regarding our street trees will ensure the future canopy and leafy outlook for which Georges River local government area is known for is enhanced and maintained.

Street trees are subjected to harsh and unnatural environments with constant impacts of increasing local population and urbanisation put upon them. This plan aims to identify these impacts and provide effective strategies to ensure there is no net loss of urban canopy cover. This will be achieved through a consistent approach of appropriate species selection, planting site selection and establishment practices.

Street trees comprise approximately 30% of the Georges River local government (LGA) area tree population. With over 32,000 street trees they are a large part of the urban forest and green infrastructure.

Establishing mature tree canopy takes time. It is important to protect and enhance both new and existing trees to maintain and extend canopy coverage.

Street trees provide benefits including:

- **Pollution Control** - Trees help to reduce atmospheric particulates and gases, they capture carbon dioxide as part of their natural process of photosynthesis converting it to oxygen for us to breathe. Trees can significantly reduce stormwater runoff. Their roots absorb the water while their leaves slow the impact of the rainfall thereby reducing the load on stormwater systems.
- **Global warming & heat Island resilience** - Trees act as insulation from heat, glare, solar radiation and the impacts of the heat island effect. Street trees provide a natural cooling effect by providing shade over hard surfaces and minimise evaporation of soil moisture.
- **Biodiversity / Habitat** - Street trees provide food and homes for native fauna. They can also provide important habitat links between isolated natural areas of the urban landscape.
- **Property Values** - Property values in streets with successful street tree planting are consistently higher than the values of similar properties which do not have street trees. Studies indicate that trees can enhance the marketability of a home and add 5% to 10% to its market value.
- **Aesthetic** – Trees in urban design help provide aesthetically pleasing and usable public spaces. Street trees can be used for screening or framing, leading or directing and highlighting or defining various features within urban areas which can soften, enhance and provide a natural, living contrast to the built environment.
- **Traffic Calming** - Trees can provide an informal method of traffic calming and help to define vehicle and pedestrian zones.




## Scope

This plan applies to street trees directly owned and managed by Georges River Council. It does not include park trees and trees located on private property. It is to provide appropriate species selection, planting site selection and establishment practices.

GRC has a responsibility to contribute to the greening & cooling of greater Sydney. It is intended that this plan highlights Council's commitment to planting, protection and management of street trees.

This plan is to complement the Georges River Tree Management Policy and is to be read in conjunction with the Tree Planting Specification 2022.



## Street Tree Species Selection

The aim of successful species selection is to ensure that the tree makes a positive contribution to the environmental, cultural and aesthetic values of the area, and to limit negative values including.

- Damage to kerb, gutters and footpaths
- Conflict with infrastructure both above and below ground.
- Excessive fruit, flower or leaf debris
- Staining of public and private assets
- Potential for seed spread in bushland.



Diversity of tree species can enhance biodiversity and be visually pleasing. The use of too few species creates a monoculture and increases the vulnerability of an urban canopy. Climate change, reduced water availability

and increased periods of drought requires that drought tolerance should be a criterion for species selection where possible.

Native and endemic tree canopy species contribute to the distinctive local character of the area, they are unique because they are perfectly suited to the local environment. Exotic species also provide characteristics that are desirable with several having high tolerance to root disturbance and the effects of the urban environment. The mix of exotic and native canopy trees increases the selection palette creating greater resilience of the future canopy.

Subject to verge width and constraints such as overhead power lines and building setbacks, larger growing street trees will be selected wherever possible. Species selection has been carefully considered with individual species determined for each street in the LGA based on the following environmental limitations and design criteria:

- Environmental constraints - i.e., soil depth, wind patterns, pollution, rainfall
- Physical constraints - overhead services, underground services, width and location of nature strips
- Streetscape design criteria - streetscape character, scale, road width, architecture
- Previous tree planting theme
- Growth habit: size - height and width and type of root system
- Hardiness - ability to survive with minimal or no maintenance, disease resistance, drought.
- Tolerance, longevity, coastal exposure, shallow soil depths
- Pruning requirements
- Maintaining the visual character and village atmosphere of Georges River localities
- Creation of theme plantings in streets with consistency and visual uniformity of main streets - this principle is to establish a more uniform visual character for main streets in urban centres, creating a sense of identity or 'sense of place' that complements the surrounding architectural forms and provides streets with a distinctive and recognisable character.
- Maintenance factors - selection of long-lived tree species / pruning requirements / root system.
- Selection of native trees that encourage and create wildlife corridors.
- General Solar Access- species should be selected to provide an appropriate level of solar access to dwellings.
- Bus Stops- clearances and setbacks for trees near bus stops are to be determined on a case-by-case basis.



## Street Tree Location

The position of street trees in relation to the surrounding structures and infrastructure is of critical importance to the ongoing performance of the tree and its impact on the surrounding landscape.

Prior to planting, the following needs to be considered & assessed:

- Services and utilities - underground mains and service pits and overhead wires.
- Soil depth - is there rock present or other physical limitations within the soil profile.




- Kerb, footpaths and roads - sufficient setback with adequate space within the verge for long term growth without conflict of displacement
- Sight lines – is there sufficient setback from driveways, access gates, street corners, and roundabouts.
- Vehicle and pedestrian clearances
- Views – where possible maintain existing views and vistas.
- Preservation of historical architectural elements/facades of buildings to commercial zones.
- Effect of debris on surrounding assets

Spacing of trees is site specific and will vary depending on

- Current plantings and established themes
- Tree species grown size potential.
- Location of services and infrastructure
- Maintenance requirements



Tree planting opportunities will be assessed using the following plan as a guide.



*Note: measurements are to be used as a guide and a subject to vary depending on individual site constraints*



## Street Tree Removal & Replacement Strategies

Georges River LGA has a high percentage of its tree canopy identified to have a useful life expectancy of 5-15 years. This means that it is expected that large tree removal and replacement will be increasingly required.

It is also acknowledged that many of Georges River's Street trees are subject to unfavorable pruning practices to maintain clearances from utilities, primarily overhead electric wires. This type of pruning commonly creates disfigured, aesthetically unpleasing and at times structurally defective trees.


When all practical management options of an individual tree have been exhausted, removal will be undertaken, and suitable replacement planted at next planting season with the species determined for the subject street in the species selection list of this plan. Additional locations nearby will also be considered for planting at the same time as replacements are installed.

Should Council undertake block removals replacements will be planted as soon as is practical.

Healthy, structurally sound trees will not be removed to accommodate species change, changes of species will be a gradual process based on natural attrition.

Each street within the LGA has been assessed and had two species allocated for planting, a species that will attain a larger height and a species that will attain a shorter height for use in narrow nature strips and under powerlines. Where possible the larger species is preferred. In streets that have a clearly defined species theme, where practical this theme should be continued.





# Tree Species Profiles

**Botanical Name:** *Acmena smithii*

**Common Name:** Lillypilly

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas): 15m

Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas): 7m

Requirements: Adaptable to any soil type, in an open, sunny position.

Growth Rate: Fast

Habit: Evergreen, tall upright tree with a dense green crown.

Foliage: Glossy dark green up to 3cm long.

New growth is bronze-pink.

Flowers: Creamy-white and prolific in late spring and summer.

Fruit: White, pink or lilac globular berries.



**Botanical Name:** *Alloxylon flammeum*

**Common Name:** Tree Waratah

**Family:** PROTEACEAE

Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas): 6m

Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas): 3m

Requirements: Tolerant of a range of soils

provided they are not waterlogged. Will survive extended dry periods once established but flowering is reduced under these conditions.

Growth Rate: Moderate.

Habit: Evergreen rainforest tree with a spreading crown.

Foliage: Thin textured, glossy green and elliptical.

Flowers: Bright orange-red flowers produced in spring and early summer.

Fruit: Woody follicle.



**Botanical Name:** *Angophora costata*

**Common Name:** Sydney Red Gum

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 20m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 10m

**Requirements:** Adaptable to most sites, including fully coastal sites that have a high sand content.


**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with a stout straight trunk and irregular, intricately branched open crown.

**Foliage:** Light green and lance shaped.

**Flowers:** Small, white and fragrant appearing in spring and summer.

**Fruit:** Cup-shaped ribbed woody capsule.



**Botanical Name:** *Angophora floribunda*

**Common Name:** Rough Barked Apple

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity:** 25m

**Approx. Width at Maturity:** 18m

**Requirements:** Tolerates a wide range of soils

and is suited to coastal areas.

**Growth Rate:** Moderate.

**Bark:** rough to the small branches, shortly fibrous and generally furrowed, grey to brown.

**Habit:** Evergreen single trunked Medium-sized to large tree forming a lignotuber.

**Foliage:** Adult leaves lanceolate occasionally falcate, opposite 0.6–1.5 cm long, 1–5 cm wide

**Flowers:** White-to-cream flowers recorded in January, February and December.

**Fruit:** Barrel-shaped to cup-shaped 7–1.2 cm long, 0.7–1.1 cm wide, longitudinally ribbed.



**Botanical Name:** *Angophora hispida*

**Common Name:** Dwarf Apple

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx.** Height at Maturity (Urban Areas): 7m

**Approx.** Width at Maturity (Urban Areas): 5m

**Requirements:** Tolerates a wide range of soils and is suited to coastal areas.

**Growth Rate:** Moderate.

**Habit:** Evergreen single trunked small tree with a twisted habit.

**Foliage:** Young stems and new foliage are extremely hairy.

**Flowers:** White-to-cream flowers are borne in dense terminal clusters in summer. Strongly bird attracting.

**Fruit:** Ovoid or campanulate 14–20 mm in diameter.



**Botanical Name:** *Arbutus unedo*

**Common Name:** Irish Strawberry Tree

**Family:** ERICACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 5m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 2.5m

**Requirements:** A well-drained fertile soil in a sunny position. Tolerates wind and lime soils.

**Growth Rate:** Slow.

**Habit:** Evergreen with a slender, erect trunk reddish bark and a dense crown.

**Foliage:** Deep-green glossy oblong leaves with a toothed margin.

**Flowers:** White, cup shaped and profuse in autumn and winter.

**Fruit:** Round, red berries that resemble strawberries.



**Botanical Name:** *Banksia integrifolia*

**Common Name:** Coast Banksia

**Family:** PROTEACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 15m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 6m

**Requirements:** Adaptable to any noncompacted, sandy soil. Will tolerate full coastal exposure.

**Growth Rate:** Fast

**Habit:** Upright, opening with age.

**Foliage:** Thick and leathery, dark green on the upper surface and bright silver below.

**Flowers:** The flowers appear on 2-year-old growth, are up to 120mm long and pale yellow.

**Fruit:** The seed heads are dark brown, ornamental and persistent on the tree for many years.



**Botanical Name:** *Buckinghamia celsissima*

**Common Name:** Ivory Curl Tree

**Family:** PROTEACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 8m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 4m

**Requirements:** Adaptable to most soils. Frost tender.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with a spreading rounded crown.

**Foliage:** Glossy green above paler below with fine silvery hairs.

**Flowers:** Sweetly scented white racemes 200mm long.

**Fruit:** Dark brown woody follicles.



**Botanical Name:** *Caesalpinia ferrea*

**Common Name:** Leopard Tree

**Family:** CAESALPINIACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 10m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 6m

**Requirements:** Prefers a moist, free draining, fertile soil in a sunny position.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Medium evergreen tree with a main trunk and branches forming a distinct elevated crown.

**Foliage:** Finely pinnate.

**Flowers:** Yellow spikes appearing in summer and autumn.

**Fruit:** Long pods containing smooth attractive seeds.



**Botanical Name:** *Callistemon citrinus*

**Common Name:** Crimson Bottlebrush

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx.** Height at Maturity (Urban Areas): 3-4m

**Approx.** Width at Maturity (Urban Areas): 2-3m

**Requirements:** grows well in a variety of soils. Drought tolerant once established. Needs full sun to maximise flowering.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with an oval form, weeping limbs and a light canopy.

**Foliage:** Oblong to lanceolate shaped leaves.

Bronze coloured when young.

**Flowers:** In this species, spikes are to 10 cm long, to 7 cm diameter; filaments bright red, sometimes purplish red or lilac with anthers dark. Flowers are produced in late spring, summer and autumn with two flowerings if some moisture is provided.

**Fruit:** Minimal; hard woody capsules.

**Note:** Some herbaria are calling this species *Melaleuca citrina* based on a reclassification by the Late Lynley Craven (1945-2014) where all species of *Callistemon* were re-classified as *Melaleuca* spp. The National Herbarium of NSW currently still retains the former classification.



**Botanical Name:** *Callistemon viminalis*

'Kings Park Special'

**Common Name:** Bottlebrush Cultivars

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):**

'Harkness' 6m, 'Kings Park Special' 4m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):**

'Harkness' 4m, 'Kings Park Special' 3m.

**Requirements:** Both cultivars grow well in a variety of soils. Drought tolerant once established.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with an oval form, weeping limbs and a light canopy.

**Foliage:** Oblong to lanceolate shaped leaves.

Bronze coloured when young.

**Flowers:** Crimson-red bottlebrushes, borne in late spring and early summer.

**Fruit:** Minimal; hard woody capsules.



**Botanical Name:** *Corymbia eximia*

**Common Name:** Yellow Bloodwood

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 15m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 7m

**Requirements:** Adapts well to poor, gravelly or sandy soils. Drought tolerant but frost tender.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with an upright trunk and a broadly conical crown.

**Foliage:** Broad-lanceolate maturing to narrow lanceolate with age. Glossy grey-green up to 180mm long.

**Flowers:** Spring flowering, normally from August to October with a mass of creamy blooms.

**Fruit:** Urn shaped woody capsule.



**Botanical Name:** *Corymbia ficifolia*

**Common Name:** Red Flowering Gum

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 8m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 6m

**Requirements:** Adaptable but prefers moist, well-drained acid and sandy soils.

**Growth Rate:** Moderate

**Habit:** Evergreen oval to spreading umbrella form with a dense canopy.

**Foliage:** Dark green, smooth, narrow leaves

**Flowers:** Showy bright red to pink and orange flowers appearing throughout summer.

**Fruit:** Seed capsule shaped like a rounded urn persistent on tree after flowering.



**Botanical Name:** *Cupaniopsis anacardiooides*

**Common Name:** Tuckeroo

**Family:** SAPINDACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 10m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 4m

**Requirements:** Well-drained soils.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Dense, spreading crown.

**Foliage:** Glossy green, alternate.

**Flowers:** Grayish white, inconspicuous flower.

**Fruit:** Black or dark brown seeds nearly covered by a bright red aril.



**Botanical Name:** *Elaeocarpus reticulatus*

**Common Name:** Blueberry Ash

**Family:** ELAEOCARPACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 10m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 5m

**Requirements:** Very adaptable yet prefers full sun with moist rich sandy-loam soils.

**Growth Rate:** Slow at first but moderately vigorous once established.

**Habit:** Evergreen with an upright form tapering towards the apex.

**Foliage:** New foliage bronze-red often with a waxy white coating aging to dark green.

**Flowers:** Elegant, white fringed bells hanging in pendulous clusters. Faintly fragrant and appearing in late spring.

**Fruit:** Rounded berry 10mm in diameter.



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus botryoides*

**Common Name:** Bangalay

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 20m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 8m

**Requirements:** Grows well in fertile, alluvial to sandy soils


**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Tall upright Eucalypt with broad, spreading canopy

**Foliage:** Dark green, thick and glossy. Curved lanceolate.

**Flowers:** Creamy white appearing in summer.

**Fruit:** Woody capsules, barrel shaped, valves level with rim



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus cinerea*

**Common Name:** Argyle Apple

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity:** 8-18m

**Approx. Width at Maturity:** 8-15m

**Requirements:** Acid, Neutral Ph, Well-drained Loamy, Sandy loam, Clay loam. Tolerates light frost.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Tall upright tree, it has rough, fibrous bark on the trunk and branches.

**Foliage:** Usually only juvenile, silvery blue-green rounded evergreen leaves.

**Flowers:** Creamy appearing in spring, summer.

**Fruit:** Mature buds are glaucous, diamond-shaped, 6–8 mm long and 3–5 mm wide



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus haemastoma*

**Common Name:** Scribbly Gum

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 11 m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 8m

**Requirements:** Prefers poor, shallow soils in an open, sunny position.


**Growth Rate:** Moderate.

**Habit:** Medium sized evergreen tree with a short crooked trunk.

**Foliage:** Dull grey-green juvenile leaves aging to thick, broad-lanceolate adult leaves 120mm long.

**Flowers:** Small and white, borne in autumn and spring.

**Fruit:** Conical or pear-shaped capsule.



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus microcorys*

**Common Name:** Tallowwood

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 20m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 8m

**Requirements:** Grows well in fertile, acid to neutral soils, but not extremely alkaline soils.

**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with a straight trunk and an irregular open crown.

**Foliage:** Broad-lanceolate with a sharp point.

Glossy green above and paler below.

**Flowers:** Creamy white appearing in winter, spring and early summer.

**Fruit:** Conical woody capsule.



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus piperita*

**Common Name:** Sydney Peppermint Gum

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity:** 10-18m

**Approx. Width at Maturity:** 8-10m

**Requirements:** Suits most soil types. Prefers moist, well-drained soil, tolerates dry periods.



**Growth Rate:** fast.

**Habit:** Medium sized evergreen tree

**Foliage:** lanceolate to falcate alternating up the stems, 8-20 cm long, 10-47 mm wide, dull, green to blue-green or grey green

**Flowers:** white flowers Summer-Autumn.

**Fruit:** barrel-shaped, 5-8 mm in diameter.



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus punctata*

**Common Name:** Grey Gum

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity:** 18-25m

**Approx. Width at Maturity:** 10-18m

**Requirements:** Suits most soil types. Prefers moist, well-drained soil, tolerates dry periods.

**Growth Rate:** fast.

**Habit** Tall and upright with a spreading

Crown. The bark sheds in about three phases over a year, the newly exposed bark being highly coloured, orange or coppery, and fades to grey which weathers to dark grey, giving a three-coloured mottled effect.

**Foliage:** Juvenile leaves narrow-lanceolate to lanceolate, glossy green.

Adult leaves alternate lanceolate, 80–150 mm long, 15–30 mm wide, dark green, glossy,

**Flowers:** white flowers Summer-Autumn.

**Fruit:** barrel-shaped, 5-8 mm in diameter.



**Botanical Name:** *Eucalyptus sideroxylon*

**Common Name:** Red ironbark, Ironbark, Mugga

**Family:** MYRTACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 15m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 6-10m

**Requirements:** Prefers full sun and will tolerate most soils. Can grow in very infertile soil. A hardy tree that can grow in areas of very little rainfall but can also tolerate high rainfall.


**Growth Rate:** Fast.

**Habit:** Evergreen with a straight trunk and an irregular open crown, Forming a lignotuber.

**Foliage:** Adult leaves alternate, petiole 0.5–2.5 cm long; blade lanceolate, 5–14 cm long, 1–4 cm wide, base tapering to petiole, concolorous, dull, green to blue-green, grey-green, grey or glaucous

**Flowers:** white, red, pink, flowering has been recorded in April, May, June, July, August, September.

**Fruit:** Cup-shaped



**Botanical Name:** *Fraxinus griffithii*

**Common Name:** Evergreen Ash

**Family:** OLEACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 6m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 4m

**Requirements:** Tolerates a range of conditions including coastal and urban stresses, but performs best in moist, well drained soils in full sun.

**Growth Rate:** Moderate.

**Habit:** Evergreen with a moderately rounded form.

**Foliage:** Glossy pinnate deep green leaves.

**Flowers:** Fragrant, decorative white flowers, produced in clusters.

**Fruit:** Samaras that remain on the tree until the winter months.



**Botanical Name:** *Fraxinus pennsylvanica*

'Cimmzam'

**Common Name:** Green Ash

**Family:** OLEACEAE

Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas): 13m

Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas): 5m

Requirements: Tolerant of cold winters and hot summers, and compacted soils.


Growth Rate: Fast.

Habit: Deciduous. Pyramidal when young, opening with age.

Foliage: Dark green, shining foliage to 300mm long. Autumn foliage is a dark, rich red colour.

Flowers: Inconspicuous flowers.

Fruit: Female plants produce samaras.



**Botanical Name:** *Fraxinus oxycarpa 'Raywoodii'*

**Common Name:** Claret Ash

**Family:** OLEACEAE

Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas): 15m

Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas): 10m

Requirements: Prefers well drained soil in an open sunny position.

Growth Rate: Moderate.

Habit: Deciduous with a narrow dome aging to medium domed crown.

Foliage: Shiny dark green, turning claret ash in autumn.

Flowers: Inconspicuous with no ornamental value.

Fruit: Yellow brown in upright clusters.



**Flowers:** White crinkled petals with yellow stamens. Single or in small clusters mid autumn to early spring.

**Common Name:** Tulipwood

**Family:** SAPINDACEAE

**Approx. Height at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 8m

**Approx. Width at Maturity (Urban Areas):** 5m

**Requirements:** tolerates salt air, pollution, drought and frost

**Growth Rate:** fast.



**Fruit:** Small capsule green aging to brown in winter.







**Habit:** Small domed spreading semi deciduous.






